Christian Star Academy School Supply List – 2022-2023

Note: The pictures on all items should be acceptable to the Lord.

Each student needs to bring all of the following items (except those noted by age):

LARGE (FAMILY SIZE) PACKAGE OF TABLE NAPKINS PER STUDENT – Each student must use two napkins at every lunch.
BACKPACKS MAY BE USED THIS YEAR – (NOT REQUIRED)
<u>TWO WATER BOTTLES (LEAK-PROOF LID; NO STRAWS)</u> – Please make sure these are made of DURABLE plastic/metal. [Please put your child's name on both. One will be his/her daily water bottle while the other will be stored at the school as a backup.] <u>No recyclable water bottles will be permitted.</u>
TWO PACKS OF COPY PAPER PER STUDENT – 500 SHEETS
ONE 2" THREE RING BINDER – (AGES 11 AND UP) – Binder should have inside, bottom pockets and sturdy, non-flexible sides. Please keep in mind that your student may need more than one binder during the school year.
STICK OR ROLL-ON DEODORANT - (AGES 10 AND UP) – DAILY REQUIREMENT (NO AEROSOLS) Please instruct your child how to properly use their deodorant stick to prevent it from breaking off and littering carpet. Some students tend to leave a trail. A mild body cologne is also permissible and nice, but not in aerosol form.
ONE PAIR OF INEXPENSIVE SNEAKERS – These will be kept at school as inside shoes. (Velcro is great for the younger students. These <u>MUST NOT BE SLIPPERS</u> and <i>it is essential</i> that they are DURABLE and FIT WELL , secured on your child's feet. Croc-like shoes are okay for indoor wear only (with socks), as long as the back straps are used properly. NO GLITTER, PLEASE!)
<u>TOILET TISSUES (DOUBLE ROLL, 2-PLY)</u> — Larger rolls, such as MEGA or JUMBO ROLLS, are also appreciated. (These last longer and less time is spent changing rolls.)
PAPER TOWELS (2-PLY)
ANTIBACTERIAL LIQUID HAND SOAP REFILLS – (Note: We have <u>plenty</u> of dispensers!)
DRAWSTRING KITCHEN TRASH BAGS – Quality, strong trash bags needed; scented trash bags are nice.

ATTENTION: PLEASE READ THIS CAREFULLY AND COMPLETELY APPROPRIATE OUTSIDE SHOES

PLEASE SEND YOUR CHILD TO SCHOOL IN SHOES THAT WILL BE APPROPRIATE FOR OUTSIDE USE ON THE EQUIPMENT AND RUNNING AROUND ON THE GRASS, WHICH IS SOMETIMES DAMP AND SLIPPERY.

THINGS TO KEEP IN MIND:

- Shoes should have a good gripping sole for running, are well-fitting, etc.
- Shoes should be easy for the child to put on without assistance
- Our dress code (no sandals, clogs, cowboy boots, or cleats permitted)
- Socks must be worn at all times
- Velcro/zipper shoes are a good choice to prevent tripping on those untied shoelaces

(There are so many no-tie options available now. Students need to know how to tie, but so much time here at school is wasted on instructing students to tie their shoes. It seems as if some shoelaces these days just refuse to stay tied – no matter who ties them! Untied shoelaces dragging on the floor become a real safety issue for your child and others.)

A number of students have been wearing inappropriate footwear for recess. Boots (of any type – snow, rain, or work boots, etc.) should not be worn, except in snowy weather. They are <u>not appropriate</u> for playing outside. Students cannot run freely or safely in them. Please make sure your child understands this important safety rule.

Also, please make sure your child can *easily* and *independently* change into their outside or inside shoes. Some students miss several minutes of their recess or work time just trying to change shoes.

NO ELECTRONIC DEVICES, GUM, OR CANDY ARE ALLOWED ON THE STUDENT.
